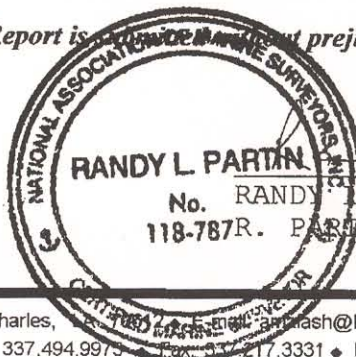

SURVEYORS' STATEMENTS

No opinion is given as to seaworthiness expressed or implied. Voids were inspected from the deck of the barge and measured with a steel gauging tape. No hopper or cargo tank inspection was conducted and no opinion is expressed regarding suitability for loading. Barge was measured while afloat at Devall Barge Fleet - Intracoastal Waterway Mile 243, Carlyss, LA. * Fleet personnel pumped water from hull voids for 2 days and indicated that their system for pumping could not remove all of the water in the tanks. Surveyor took measurements on the remaining water and estimated the quantity to be 103 s/t. Pumps were able to remove 436 s/t of water from the time of the original measurements on November 19, 2004.

This Survey was undertaken and Survey Report is given without prejudice and for the benefit of whom it may concern.
